BugHouse is played by teams of 2 players. 2 chessboards are placed side-by-side with partners sitting on the same side of the table. Each plays a standard game but with a special feature -- a captured piece is given to ones partner. Once received, the piece is in 'reserve.' On a player's turn, s/he can either make a standard chess move or place a reserve piece onto the board.
