Your Chess Club

The Los Amigos Chess Club meets Wednesday's from 3:05 – 4:35pm, 10/11/17 through 04/25/18. The registration fee is \$80 per member which includes all 24, 90-minute sessions.

NEW CLUB MEMBERS & ALL THOSE IN GRADES K-2:

The first 5 weeks of chess club will be learning/reviewing each chess piece, how they move and how to play their individual Chess Mini-Game[®]. It's important for members in grades Kindergarten, First and Second, as well as those new to the Los Amigos Chess Club to attend during this time because this is when structure and routines are established. That makes it easier for students to understand the club's processes for the rest of the year.

RETURNING MEMBERS, GRADES 3-8:

The first 5 weeks this group will have three choices:

1) Participate in the Chess Mini-Game[®] lessons and practices

2) Volunteer to help those learning the Chess Mini-Games[©]

3) Play and practice Full Games, report each game's results, and receive coaching After the first 5 weeks, K-8 will join together for the rest of the year.

ALL MEMBERS:

On November 15, we will be having a Pot Luck Party to celebrate the combining of the two groups. We will have a Pillar Game Tournament 3:05-4:05pm and the Pot Luck will start at 4:05pm. From November 15 through April 25, students will not be divided into the previous two sections. They will be one large group. However, lessons will still be provided to small groups each week

On April 25, we will have our second Pot Luck Party to celebrate the end-of-year Awards Ceremony, where 1/3 of all participants will earn a trophy and all participants will receive a certificate.

There will be various opportunities for members to play chess matches both in-house and against other schools, as well as to be a part of the Los Amigos Chess Team in the AV Scholastic Chess League.

Throughout the duration of the club, parents/guardians may have questions or need to discuss their child with the coach. Please choose a time when Ms. Daa is not occupied with her coaching responsibilities, make an appointment, or email her. See the "*Meet your Coach*" section for contact information.

We believe Chess Club Members will find it easy to follow the Chess Club policies such as: no hats indoors, speak in complete sentences, etc. However, *it's always helpful when parents act as role models in this area.*

VOLUNTEERS DO NOT NEED TO KNOW HOW TO PLAY CHESS!

In a typical Chess Club, a few parents take it upon themselves to volunteer at every Chess Club Meeting and those volunteers make a lasting impression on the children for their commitment.

It is because of that core group that each Chess Club Member's parent/guardian need volunteer for only one meeting per semester, though you are always welcome to volunteer for more.

A volunteer's role is to assist the Chess Coach by: monitoring the students, guiding them station to station, check-in and check-out procedures, supervising set-up and pack-up, etc.

Without volunteers, the coach is unable to give the small-group lessons each week that enable each child to improve her/his chess play and otherwise have a positive and successful Chess Club experience.

4 th Incident:	Written statement revoking the student's Chess Club Membership for the rest 2017/2018 school year
